<p>FDL County Map distribution</p>	<p>Maps are available at the following: YMCA, Senior Center, county Clerk's office, Exec's office, Planning/Parks, FDL Cyclery. 120 maps were distributed at the county employee health fair in April.</p> <p>Sam Tobias included the following report on progress of bike routes in FDL county:  The county, city, Noon Rotary (\$15,000 gift) and an Aid for the Development of Local Parks grant will be used this year to finish paving the last ¼ mile of the Prairie Trail off of Martin Avenue. What is now gravel will be asphalt pavement. Pavement will be 20-feet wide, the turn around and the small parking area will also be paved.</p> <p>The county, as part of reconstruction of Pioneer Road between Hickory and Military Road, will include an extension of the side path. Likely next year. Work on this project should start in Spring 2016 for Taft Road east to the county line and Spring 2017 for Taft Road west to the FdL bypass. When complete, the Plank Trail will connect FdL and Sheboygan. Doc will be able to ride his bike to Lake Michigan from FdL on the path, swim 4-5 miles in the lake, and hop on his bike and ride back home to FdL.</p> <p>The city is working on marking a bike route on city streets to connect the new north end of the Wild Goose Trail to trails within the city.</p>
