Community Health Improvement Plan: Marketing Plan Update	Marian Sheridan shared the new marketing poster to be distributed to key places/groups throughout the community. Plan to have a breakfast gathering at Agnesian as a kickoff to share where we are. Idea to have a key note speaker with a public health background was discussed. Ideas were discussed to have the breakfast sometime in May, marketing group to discuss further. Sandi Roehrig and Deann Thurmer would like to be part of the marketing group. Update from Health Priority Working Groups Alcohol Use and Abuse	Marian Sheridan (reported for Bill Lamb) discussed the burden of alcohol being both personal and economic. Discussed drug-free communities. Evidenced-based best practices are being developed. Submitted grant to help target the population of people with this specific problem. Saturation patrols named two key events to target; super bowl and St. Patrick's Day. Compliance checks continue. Many great partnerships are evolving and one to include the county specifically. Erin Gerred will work on getting a contact person involved. Marian mentioned we need to start finding new ways to increase sustainability and need to concentrate on the coordination piece. Dental Access	Kim Mueller discussed Save-a-Smile expansion into adult population to treat emergent needs at this time. Save-a-Smile is working with Agnesian to help fund emergent needs of adults only at this time. Plans are being discussed to expand the Save-a-Smile staff capacity so in the future more children and more adults will be served. Fluoridation letter went out to all communities who do not have fluoride in their water and are below the recommended levels. Kim will work on creating a list of all communities in need of fluoride. Plans discussed to expand dental services to daycares. Save-a-Smile will start in Playhouse 4 the Precious.	Continuing implementation	Kim Mueller
Mental Health	Greg Brewer and Marian Sheridan discussed CSI. Plan is to link CSI together. Discussed teen screen and PBIS. Grant submitted through Milwaukee – issue being mental health (collaborative, early intervention for young children is needed). Will find out in May if group can submit grant in June and will find out if accepted in Oct (grant is \$200,000 for 2 years). Obesity and Overweight	Marty Ryan reported coordinator, Kya Schnettler, started and is getting her feet on the ground. Her office is at the YMCA. Work is on focusing the group and is going well. Working with Farmers Markets and food shares, establishing vendors at YMCA in the summer. Working on vendor to show how to prepare food. Discussed Y5210 (3 rd graders are expert). Restaurants to have healthy facts, green thumbs up, yellow thumb and red thumb to help consumer decide health choice. Working on bike to school week.
